

**Downtown Rogers Rotary Club 7th Annual Frisco Inferno
October 8, 2022
Barbeque Competition Rules**

Thank you for your participation in the 7th annual Frisco Inferno Barbeque Competition presented by the Downtown Rogers Rotary Club. This competition is the club's primary annual fundraising event, and your participation not only enables the event to take place but is also direct support of the club's mission to make downtown Rogers, and the world, a better place to live. We are sincerely grateful for your participation and support.

This year's event will again be featured as the Premier BBQ Venue for Bikes Blues and BBQ – which is one of the 5 largest motorcycle rallies in the United States. We anticipate selling up to 1,000 tickets to participants for this event. There will be several thousand people throughout downtown Rogers on this day, exploring our great city.

The details for competition participants are:

Entry Fee: \$250.00

Which includes entry into the competition and 2 complimentary tickets to the event. Each team will be provided with a 20' x 20' space for the competition, no exceptions. Registration will be open in July on-line at www.friscoinferno.com.

Competition Awards:

We have created two ways to be a winner: The "Judges' Choice Award" for 2 meat categories, pork and chicken. Each team will receive 2 pork butts and 30 lbs of chicken quarters.

A group of five individual, non-partisan, experienced competition judges for each of the meat categories will sample the participants' fare and determine who has cooked the best smoked meat. Through voting, the judges will determine the winners for each category of meat. Each category will be awarded \$1,000 for 1st place, \$500 for 2nd place, and \$250 for 3rd. Additionally, trophies will be awarded for each place for both meat categories.

The rules of competition are as follows:

1. Meat will be given to each participating team at noon on Friday, October 7th at the site of the event.
2. The meat must be 100% prepared and cooked on site. If it is removed from the premises the team will be disqualified from trophy consideration.
3. The participants can utilize any method in cooking that they deem appropriate. Their fare must be cooked and ready to serve by the start of the event - 12:00 noon on Saturday, October 8th.
4. Condiments and sides that are intended to stretch your portions can be processed off site.
5. The event will run for 2 hours from 12:00 noon until 2:00 p.m. During this time, you will be expected to serve the ticket-holding attendees and provide samples of each meat to the judges. The winners will be announced after the tasting has concluded.
6. By submitting your entrance fee, you agree as a participant to the above rules.

Regardless of where you end up after the votes are cast, everybody is a winner in this fun fund raising and community event.
